Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Analog Policy regarding Conflict Minerals and the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act 2010.

Conflict minerals refers to minerals mined in conditions of armed conflict and human rights abuses, notably in the eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries. The most commonly mined minerals are Cassiterite (used to produce tin), Wolframite (used to produce tungsten), Coltan (used to produce tantalum), and Gold.

To the best of our knowledge and belief, Analog products do not contain any of these minerals that originate or have been sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or surrounding countries.

Analog are committed to working with our supply chain and only sourcing components and materials from suppliers that share our company values regarding ethics and human rights. We are also committed to ensure that any existing or potential new companies in our supply chain do not fall into these categories by carrying due diligence through written evidence where applicable.

Analog will continue to monitoring the situation regarding conflict minerals and take necessary actions as appropriate in line with new developments.
